### **The purpose of the BSJ**

The Pastor has ultimate responsibility for the parish, and within it for the school. It is the **Pastor** (or in AIM Schools, the **Superintendent** or her representative, the **Assistant Superintendent** for the Vicariate) who establishes the **Board of Specified Jurisdiction**.

The BSJ is intended to bring professional expertise in the specified areas of

**Planning,**

**Development,**

**Finances and Facilities Maintenance,**

**Marketing, Recruitment, and Enrollment Management**

to enhance the educational and spiritual leadership of the principal and pastor. The Pastor and Principal do not relinquish their leadership in education and Catholic identity and practice; they welcome the Board to collaborate in providing for a strong and vital infrastructure for the school in the specified areas.
