# ACT ASPIRE Tenant Rollover Information

- All Principals should have received this message from ACT and OCS.
- This process is the same process as last year.
- All summative reports are still available as well as all student data in a cumulative student performance data.
- The only files that are not available are individual interim reports and reports available through the “educator” tab. These reports can also be found via the school tab and are not deleted.



# ACT ASPIRE Scores and Other Updates

- **Writing Scores:** ACT did not provide cumulative writing scores for the test. OCS is currently working to provide schools with data on grade level performance on specific strands.
- This process has taken longer than expected and will most likely go into September and early October.
- **Communication of ACT ASPIRE scores:**

3. Formative Assessment of Continuous School Improvement Plan by **Friday, January 25, 2019.**



# Helpful Tips in completing the CSIP

- **Locally Save File:** Add items through Microsoft Excel before sharing on Google Drive
- **Added Goals/Input for Action Plan for Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade:** Additional options to add goals and standards for Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade.
- **3 Years of Data:** You can copy and paste from previous CSIP into tables
- **Improved Ease in Inputting Standards:** Standards auto-populate once selected. Non-priority standards have to be added.
- **Google Drive:** Same process as last year; please place in your school improvement folder and alert your RD when its completed.



# Strategies and Other Items to Consider when Implementing your CSIP

- Identifying appropriate and priority standards and skill areas:
  - Name 1-2 key standards/link standards and skills across grade levels.
- Implementing high impact instructional strategies:
  - Specific, best practice-research based strategies
- Monitoring of instructional strategies and described student engagement activities
  - What is your targeted plan to review and assess teacher implementation of these strategies?
- Quality of assessment strategies
  - Quizlets, teacher created and reviewed formative assessments, interims.
