### **Improvement Priority # 1**

Design and execute a comprehensive two-way communication plan that monitors and involves all stakeholders in all aspects of the system to ensure support of focus on student performance and the Archdiocesan purpose and direction. Indicators: 2.5, 3.5, 3.8, 5.5

### **Improvement Priority # 2**

Develop a systematic process to review, revise, and implement curriculum standards reflective of 21<sup>st</sup> century instruction and learning strategies across all subject areas. Indicators 3.1, 3.3, 3.6

### **Improvement Priority # 3**

Improve the consistency of curricular expectations and grading and reporting of student performance across the system. Indicators 3.1, 3.2, 3.10

### **Improvement Priority # 4**

Provide training and support for instructional staff in the analysis, interpretation, and application of data to improve student learning and engagement through differentiated instructional practices that align with individual student needs. Indicators 5.2, 5.3

**Improvement Priority # 5**

Review and align the administrator and teacher supervision and performance evaluation tools to reflect standards and benchmarks for effective Catholic schools in order to enhance and impact effective pedagogy. Indicators 2.6, 3.4

**Improvement Priority # 6**

Conduct a system-wide facilities audit to assess building maintenance and cleanliness for health and safety. Indicator 4.3
