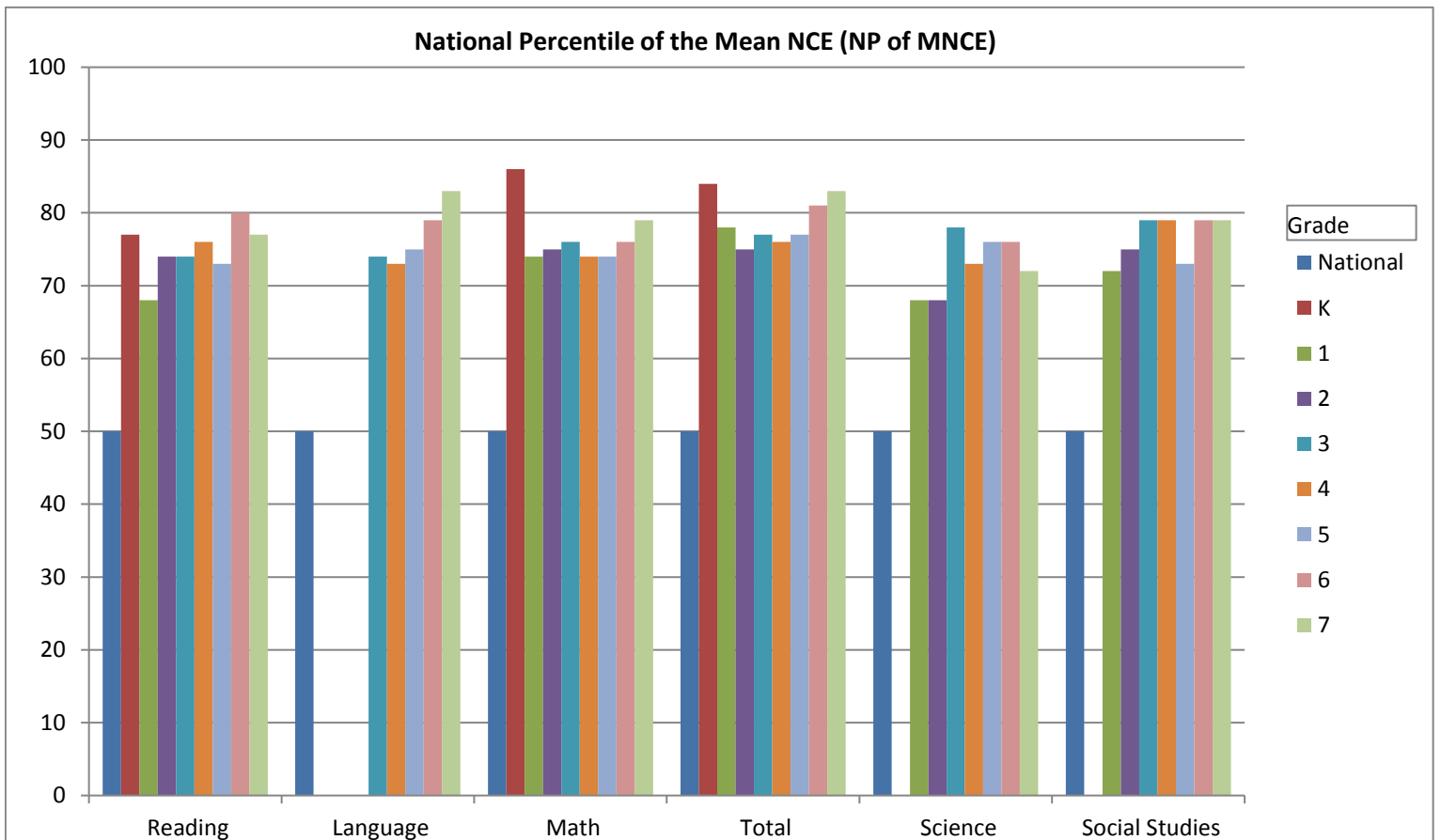

NP of Mean NCE is simply the National Percentile Rank of the Average Score (NCE) of the Group of Students Tested
 For Example, a Grade 7 Reading NP of MNCE score of 77 means the average student in 7th grade is ranked higher than 77 % of the nation in Reading
