The Early Screening Inventory-Revised (ESI-R™) 2008 Edition provides a brief developmental screening instrument designed to be individually administered to children from 3.5 to 5.11 years of age. It identifies children who may need special education services in order to perform successfully in school. Research has shown the ESI-R to be highly reliable and valid.

The instrument is available for two age groups, Preschool and Kindergarten:

- The Early Screening Inventory-**Preschool** (ESI-P) for ages 3.0 through 4.5 years
 - The Early Screening Inventory-**Kindergarten** (ESI-K) for ages 4.6 through 5.11 years
- Separate versions of the score sheets are available for the ESI-P and ESI-K.*

Features

The instrument addresses developmental, sensory, and behavioral concerns in the following areas:

- Visual Motor/Adaptive
- Language and Cognition
- Gross Motor Skills

What's in an ESI-R kit?

- Examiner's Manual
- Screening materials (manipulatives for administering: 4 shape and 6 picture cards, 10 natural wood blocks and one green block, button, rubber ball, toy car, reusable 8-foot tape. These materials are the same for both Preschool & Kindergarten)
- 30 Parent Questionnaires-English
- Pkg. of 30 score sheets-English

The ESI-R Preschool kits (English) were ordered for all the PFA schools. Additional score sheets for Kindergarten (ages 4.6 to 5.11 years) were also ordered. For the schools with Spanish-speaking populations, Spanish Parent Questionnaires were also ordered. One ESI-R kit is given to each PFA school.
